COVENANT REMINDERS:

With summer coming, we want to remind everyone Recreational Vehicles, Motor Homes, Hauling Trailers, and Boats are only allowed to be parked behind the fence, not on the driveway or the street. During those times of loading and unloading, the RV or Trailer can be parked on the driveway or street 2 days for loading and 2 days for unloading.

The official verbiage can be found at: Article VIII – Use Restrictions, Section 8.7 – Restriction on Parking.

Trash: Some residents have contacted us about loose trash in the neighborhood. To avoid these problems, secure the lids of your garbage cans and tie all bags. Please place your garbage cans behind the fence or in your garage after your trash has been picked up.
