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Dumpsters

The dumpsters will be returning May 12-14. One will be on Marsh Hawk/Greenbush. The other Red Brooke/ Hawkesbury. Rules are still the same. Furniture must be broken down to 4 by 4 sections. Load front to back so that everyone can use the Dumpsters. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE WOOD ON THE BOTTOM FOR PEOPLE TO WALK OVER AS IT IS A WALKING HAZARD. Remember NO electronic devices, lead, acid, batteries, liquid waste, or wastes containing free liquids, car parts, tires, gas, paint, oil, hazard materials. Mattresses will be allowed ONLY on Sunday. The dumpsters will be locked at night. Please do not fill over the top as the company will not pick them up and the HOA will be charged extra. If we are fined for any prohibited items found in the dumpsters, the HOA will not have the dumpsters in the Fall.

Lawn Service

The board is still in the process of getting a lawn service to mow the common areas. The board does have a back up plan to still get the mowing done. However, homeowners/tenants will be responsible for 3 ft behind/ side of their fences. This way there will be no damage to fences other than by the homeowner.

Maintaining your yards

The board understands with inflation, rising costs, and climate change, maintaining the yards will be harder. If you have grass, please continue to maintain it the best you can. If you have dirt, you have until the end of July to have grass growing or submit plans or a contract to show you are aero scaping by the end of July. If not none of these are being done, violations will be issued starting August. (Also, if you have damage/down fence, please repair and/or notify the board of progress.)

Recreational Vehicles

All boats, RV's and Trailers will be allowed in the HOA again this summer. Starting date will be Memorial Day weekend (May 26th) through September 11th. If they are not removed by then, the board will start issuing violations.
